Once you've completed the login/registration process, you'll be able to select your event, quantity of tickets, and then proceed to PayPal's secure payment site to complete the process. Upon completion of your payment, simply **follow the return link** back to our website.

### Kalaeloa Raceway Park Rules of Admission

1. Kalaeloa Raceway Park reserves the right to refuse service to anyone. By entering this facility you agree to abide by these posted rules. If you do not agree, please leave the facility.
2. By entering this facility, all persons assume full responsibility for any and all injuries sustained, including death and/or property damage, anytime they are on race track premises or in route to or from track.
3. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs allowed on premises. Any driver/rider, crewmember or person in association with a driver/rider who is considered to be under the influence of any drug, alcohol or any judgment-impairing substance will be expelled from the race and escorted off the premises together with the entire crew and vehicle associated with the offender.
4. No glass containers allowed on premises.
5. No animals allowed on premises.
6. Children under 15 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult. All persons entering the pit area must be at least 15 years of age with proof of age and photo ID. All drivers must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license or have a written and signed waiver from their legal guardian.
7. No vulgar language, physical violence, offensive gestures or any behavior that's deemed inappropriate by track management will be allowed. Violators will be expelled immediately from the facility with the entire crew.
8. The speed limit in all off-track and pit areas is 5 mph. No burnouts are allowed on the return road or in the pit area. Violators endangering others with reckless and inconsiderate driving habits (whether it is in or on a race car or pit vehicle) will be expelled immediately from the facility with the entire crew.
9. Upon entering the facility, racers and crew members agree to abide by all rules -- and that all interpretations of rules are left up to the event organizer, who shall have final say in all matters, questions and protests.
10. Drivers are responsible for the conduct of their owner and crew.
